About the Ministry

Unity of Santa Maria

Unity of Santa Maria is located in the community known as Orcutt in a residential area of newly built houses and older homes. The population of Santa Maria/Orcutt is approximately 150,000 and is mainly an agricultural community. There has been an influx of wineries in recent years along the central coast, which has shifted the focus from ranching to California's robust wine industry. There is a park within walking distance with hiking trails, a picnic area, soccer fields, and a dog park.

Unity of Santa Maria sits on a property of approximately two acres. There is a house, built in the 60's where services used to be held prior to the chapel being built in the 1980's. The Chapel of Light is a beautiful, unique chapel with a glass pyramid dome that lets in light. The walls are wood. There is a baby grand piano and musicians love our space due to the excellent acoustics. There are monitors (3) mounted on the walls and a sound system. The chapel seats 250 people, theater style. There is a prayer room and supply room, along with an attic for storage, and an inviting entrance with a foyer and handicap-accessible bathrooms.

The grounds are well-landscaped and there is plenty of shade from the trees that grace the property. There is a memorial garden to remember our beloved supporters.

Locality: Unity of Santa Maria is located in North Santa Barbara County on the beautiful Central Coast of California, smack between Los Angeles to the south and San Francisco to the north. We are 70 miles north of Santa Barbara and 25 miles south of Pismo Beach and 40 miles from San Luis Obispo, which has an easily accessible airport and is the home of Cal-Poly.

We have a year-round median temperature of 72 degrees and our area boasts many hiking trails, vineyards and beaches close by.

Popular attractions include the beautiful beaches along the coastline for day use, camping, surfing and dog walking. There are lakes nearby: Lopez Lake and Oso Flaco lake. Bird watching, hiking, swimming, biking, horse riding are some of the outdoor activities to be enjoyed.

Santa Maria boasts the Pacific Conservatory of Performing Arts (PCPA) which features professionally acted and directed plays. For the light-hearted, there is the Melodrama playhouse. The local colleges present music and dance performances. There are concerts from the Santa Maria Philharmonic Orchestra and a ukulele band through the OASIS senior center. Unity of Santa Maria is in close proximity to colleges, universities, and Vandenberg Space Force Base.

The Old Orcutt section of town offers a variety of restaurants, both established and new. Within Santa Maria, there are yoga studios, gyms, and Pilates studios. Popular events in the area include Hispanic, Native American, and Japanese festivals.

Proximity to Other Unity Ministries and/or New Thought Centers:

There is an active Unity ministry in Arroyo Grande approximately 20 miles north. We have a good relationship with them. The San Luis Obispo Unity is now online only. There is a Unity of Santa Barbara 75 miles south.

We are seeking a minister who has leadership skills, who teaches spiritual principles and lives the principles. Sunday service presented in an engaging manner that inspires both our hearts and minds.
