- 1. In 2007, we held a 90-day Novena/Prayer for guidance regarding our current financial situation and outdated buildings. Before the 90-day Novena ended, a very generous offer was presented on the property. The sale financed the purchase and remodel of our current location, and a new administration building that includes an upstairs apartment. The sale continues to financially support our ministry from investments we made.
- 2. We went through a CLRMT review that led to disaffiliation. Since then, we have healed, grown, and are now reaffiliated.
- 3. In 2009, completed and moved into present location debt free.
