Rev. Valerie Mansfield has been the Senior Minister at Unity of East Louisville, Kentucky since March 2022. Prior to serving as its senior minister, she served as the ministry consultant. In that role she trained the Board of Trustees in reorganization of the ministry, including governance, administration, worship, social justice, and other activities to advance the mission. She assisted with the reorganization of bylaws, policies & procedures and moved them into Full Ministry Status at UWM.

Prior to her tenure at Unity of East Louisville, Rev. Valerie served in positions of Associate Minister and Senior Minister for Unity of Louisville, Inc. in Louisville-Jefferson County, Kentucky. She has also worked as a Spiritual Director and an Adjunct Professor for Unity Worldwide Ministries.

In addition to graduating and being ordained as a Unity minister from Unity Spiritual Institute in 2013, Rev. Valerie earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Public Policy Analysis from the University of Louisville.

She is currently the Treasurer for Unity Worldwide Ministries Board of Trustees, Chair of the Budget and Finance Committee (which establishes policies for checks and balances and the Quasi Board Endowment). She also serves on the Executive Team, Bylaws Committee and Interfaith Committee.

Rev. Valerie's community involvement includes being a member of Beloved Community, Louisville working to reduce violence through sustainable policies.
