Note: The annual convention business meeting is **on Thursday** this year, **June 20, 2019, 9–11:30 a.m.** (revised)

Ministries (except alternative ministries) are allowed four delegates at the [annual business meeting](#). Delegates should have a letter from the ministry on church letterhead, signed by the minister or board, specifying that they are an authorized delegate of the ministry.

Because spiritual leaders are not Unity-credentialed, and thus not a member of UWM to vote, they will need to use one of the ministry's delegate votes.

A licensed Unity teacher (LUT) can only vote if designated as a delegate of the ministry.

There is no charge to attend only the business meeting, but you *must register onsite* to receive a qualifying nametag and voter packet. Unity ministers automatically are allowed to vote, unless they are in not-in-good-standing status.

For alternative ministries, the minister is the only one allowed to vote. There are no other allowed delegates.
