“In August of 1976 I set off from Olympia, Washington, with my 5-year-old son and all our possessions for Unity Village and my entry into the ministerial program. It was a miracle supported by generous individuals, mentors, stipends, scholarships, and the opportunity to work in various departments at the Village. I had extraordinary instructors and received an amazing education.

“The weekend following ordination in August 1978, I interviewed and was hired to be the minister of Unity in Springfield, Illinois, where I served for 10 years. In 1988 I became the minister of Unity of Bellevue, Washington, for 10 years until 1998.

“Then for three years I was out of active ministry. For two of those years, I served on the staff of a private counseling agency specializing in sex offender treatment.

“In 2003 I was invited to Unity of Santa Barbara, California, and served there until November 2012. I am currently in my ninth year of ministerial service at Unity Skagit Valley in Mt. Vernon, Washinton.

“After 46 years in ministry, my flame still burns bright and my dedication to serving others is unwavering. Ministry for me is a privilege and an honor. I have been transformed by these teachings and am grateful to share this path of light and hope with every wonderful being I’ve met along the way. I am without sufficient words to express my gratitude for all I’ve been given.”
