Blessings to all:

We at UWM wish to keep you informed regarding the case of Freedom From Religion Foundation v. Lew, in which Judge Barbara Crabb of the Federal District Court in the Western District of Wisconsin ruled that the clergy housing allowance is unconstitutional. The government pursued an appeal with this case to the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals on Friday, January 24. We advise that you contact your local Congress person and Senators to share your position.

Based on the government's filing of a notice of appeal today, Friday, January 24, 2014, set forth below is the presumed timeline for briefing. Note that extensions of the briefing schedule are routinely granted, especially if the government requests them.
