Course Description

Teachings about the Gospels have usually portrayed Jesus Christ as the “*Great Exception*” to being human. However, by focusing upon his sayings, we can see Jesus as the “*Great Example*” for Spiritual Awakening, Empowerment, and Transformation. By exploring the teachings *of* Jesus, rather than the teachings *about* Jesus, we can follow that example. Students will develop a deeper and more practical understanding of Jesus as Master Teacher, Way-shower through reflection upon his sayings and methods. In this way, they will learn to build a strong spiritual foundation for “Christ Consciousness.”
